The Lake County Water Authority Board of Trustees, an elected body, was created by the Florida legislature in 1953 to control and conserve the freshwater resources of Lake County.

The Lake County Water Authority Board of Trustees has reviewed SB 2080 that was passed by the legislature and sent on to you. The Lake County Water Authority Board of Trustees is concerned that portions of the bill would limit the scrutiny of Water Use Permits (aka Consumptive Use Permits) normally available to the public.

The elected Lake County Water Authority Board of Trustees took action at its May 27, 2009 meeting to request that you exercise your authority to veto SB 2080 in the spirit of good government and public transparency.
