Items requested regarding RFB # 2019-04:

1st Requestor:

- a) Is 20 tons considered base load or 10 tons, or a certain cubic yards of material?

The LCWA assumed the contractor would utilize 18 cubic yard trucks to access the site for sediment removal. Those who visited the site for non-mandatory pre-bid meeting were able to see some of the logistics involved with site access and LCWA feels the above mentioned truck size would be appropriate. Therefore we would like to know the cost per load accordingly.

- b) On exhibit B it states loads of sediment Hauled to Lake Jem farms. Is that supposed to be a different bid or part of same bid price of sediment hauled to landfill, contractor site?

Lake Jem Farms was for a different project. Exhibit B is an example of a record form the contractor can use. Contractor can also provide a similar one for recorded keeping and support of their invoices.

2nd Requestor

- a) What is proposed budget for this project?

The LCWA is estimating \$50,000 to \$75,000 initially and if additional funds exist continuing removal of material with available funds at that time.
